A crucial part of the solution is already available:

low energy buildings

- Buildings account for 40% of Europe's energy use
- A low energy building requires approximately 90% less energy for heating and cooling, compared to an average existing building
- Energy efficiency measures such as insulation in all European buildings would save 460 million tonnes of CO₂/year, the equivalent of 3.3 million barrels of oil per day and would create 530,000 jobs in Europe
