Can the Energy Roadmap 2050 ignore the biggest source of energy?  
**IT CANNOT!**



- ✓ **Energy Efficiency** is a key element of EU Energy Policy today and tomorrow.
- ✓ **Buildings waste billions!** They represent **40% of EU's energy use** (67% of which is used for space heating and cooling) and **36% its CO<sub>2</sub> emissions**.
- ✓ The transition to a new EU energy model must take into consideration energy savings from the **existing building stock**.
- ✓ **90% CO<sub>2</sub> emissions reduction** in EU buildings by 2050 is feasible, by fixing a long-term target of **80% reduction of the energy use in the EU building stock by 2050**.
- ✓ These targets will not only re-launch the economy, but also have the potential to create **2 million new European jobs**.
- ✓ The obvious question is: **what is Europe waiting for?**

**Lower energy consumption in buildings IS the sustainable use of existing resources and key to reduce Europe's energy demand.**
